PROFESSIONAL ETHICS FOR COACHES

In this course, students will gain knowledge and understanding of professional ethics and legal responsibilities of coaches as outlined in the Iowa Code. This course meets the requirements for renewal of coaching authorization licenses. **STUDENTS MUST BE ABLE TO ATTEND ALL 5 HOURS TO REGISTER FOR THIS COURSE.** COST: \$ 35

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Eastern Iowa Community College District is a Department of Education Approved Provider for the Coaching Authorization Program.

State law allows non-teachers to coach school sports if they qualify for a state coaching authorization certificate. In order to qualify, you must complete the required classes. **Attendance at all classes is required.** Coaching authorization certificates will be issued by the Iowa Department of Education.

These classes are required for both paid and volunteer coaches at junior and senior high school levels. You do not need a college degree to enter this program; however, you must be 18 years old to receive the state authorization.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will any of my college credit classes transfer into the Coaching Authorization program?

It is possible that you may have taken classes that will transfer in the program. To be sure, you will need to contact the Dept. of Education:

How long does my authorization last?

Your Coaching Authorization certificate is valid for five years from the date of issue. At that point you may renew your authorization for another five years after completing five required activities.

Is it true that I need to be fingerprinted?
