### BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS

All health care personnel are at risk for exposure to bloodborne pathogens. By using some simple and effective procedures you can protect yourself, your patient, and your co-workers from the spread of infection. By increasing your awareness of prevention, transmission, and exposure to bloodborne pathogens, you can prevent an accidental exposure. Health care personnel will increase their understanding of the safeguards used to protect themselves and others against the health hazards, which can result from exposure to blood and certain body fluids containing bloodborne pathogens. 1. Understand bloodborne pathogens and how they are spread. 2. Learn the importance of the Exposure Control Plan. 3. Identify the steps to take if an accidental exposure occurs. 4. Utilize appropriate safety methods and work practice controls. 5. #### WILDFLOWER PHOTO ADVENTURE

Take a walk on the wild side at Black Hawk State Historic Site and learn about photographing spring wildflowers.
