Job Outlook

With the increasing age of the baby boom generation, the demand for people in health careers continues to grow. Iowa Workforce Development statistics indicate a 20 percent increase in jobs over a 10-year period running through 2008. Nationally, that number is even greater, with a 31 percent increase expected between 2000 and 2010. (Bureau of Labor Statistics projection.)

Earnings

According to the National Bureau of Labor Statistics, hourly wages for Emergency Medical Technicians range from \$10 to \$14 per hour and Paramedics range from \$14 per hour to \$20 per hour.
